WAR CABINET.

ANTI-U-BOAT WARFARE.

Note by the Secretary of the War Cabinet.

The Prime Minister has decided to hold a series of weekly meetings on Anti-U-Boat Warfare, on the lines of the meetings held on the Battle of the Atlantic.

These meetings will be regularly attended by the following:-

- The Prime Minister (In the Chair).
- The Lord Privy Seal. (Deputy Chairman).
- The First Lord of the Admiralty.
- The Secretary of State for Air.
- The Minister of War Transport.
- The First Sea Lord.
- The Chief of the Air Staff.

Ministers will be free to bring other technical advisers according to the particular questions under discussion.

For the present, meetings will be held regularly at 6.0 p.m. on Wednesdays.
